INDIANA VOTER'S BILL OF RIGHTS

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE – it's the law, and you have the proof in your hands! You'll notice letters and numbers after each of your rights listed below; those codes tell lawyers and poll-workers where to find the actual Indiana statute that protects your right to vote. These rights are guaranteed to properly registered and qualified voters. You have the right to take this Bill of Rights into the voting booth with you. YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE:

1. **IF YOU ARE IN LINE** at the polling place when the polls open at 6:00 A.M. or close at 6:00 P.M. Ind. Code Ann. §§ 3-11-8-8 and 3-11-8-11 (West 2008).
2. **BY REGULAR BALLOT IF YOUR NAME DOES NOT APPEAR ON THE POLL SHEET** if you were previously registered in the precinct but your name no longer appears on the poll list and you make an oral or written statement affirming that you still live at that address or if you have a receipt from a voter registration agency verifying that you registered. Ind. Code Ann. §§ 3-7-48 et seq. (West 2008).
3. **BY REGULAR BALLOT IF YOUR NAME HAS CHANGED AND YOUR PHOTO ID DOES NOT BEAR THE SAME NAME AS THE POLL LIST** after writing in your new name on the poll list. Ind. Code Ann. § 3-7-41-2 (West 2008).
4. **BY PROVISIONAL BALLOT** if you do not have photo identification on election day. Ind. Code Ann. §§ 3-10-1-7.2 and 3-11.7-2-1. (West 2008).
5. **BY PROVISIONAL BALLOT** if your name does not appear on the poll sheet and you do not meet the exceptions described above. Ind. Code Ann. §§ 3-7-48-1 and 3-11.7-2-1. (West 2008).
6. **And to REQUEST ASSISTANCE WITH VOTING IF YOU CANNOT READ OR WRITE**, or you do not read or speak English, or you are blind or otherwise disabled. Ind. Code Ann. § 3-11-9-2 (West 2008).
7. **And to RECEIVE A REPLACEMENT BALLOT** from the election officials if you make a mistake on your ballot while voting. Ind. Code Ann. § 3-11-11-18 (West 2008).

8. AT YOUR FORMER POLLING PLACE if you have moved to a new precinct within the same county and congressional district in which you were registered to vote, if you moved to a different county or congressional district in Indiana, or if you moved outside Indiana (and it is a presidential election) within 30 days from the election. Ind. Code Ann. §§ 3-10-12-3.4, 3-10-11-2 and 3-10-10-2 (West 2008).
9. And RECEIVE WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS from election officials when voting. Ind. Code Ann. § 3-11-3-22 (West 2008).
10. WITHOUT BEING SOLICITED when you are within 50 feet of the entrance to the polling place. Ind. Code Ann. § 3-14-3-16 (West 2008).
11. BY PROVISIONAL BALLOT EVEN IF SOMEONE CHALLENGES your right to vote. Ind. Code Ann. §§ 3-11-8-22.1 et seq. (West 2008).
- 12. THE INDIANA ELECTIONS DIVISION HAS CONFIRMED THAT YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO TAKE THIS BILL OF RIGHTS INTO THE VOTING BOOTH WITH YOU.**
